The Philoptochos Athenian Luncheon and Bake Sale

The Philoptochos Athenian Luncheon and Bake Sale is sponsored by The Ladies Philoptochos Society. This unique Women's group, whose primary function is to serve the needy and the poor, is an arm of the Greek Orthodox Church. In fact, the word Philoptochos means friend of the poor. Over the years the ladies of Philoptochos have expanded their endeavors with fundraising efforts that benefit charities at local, regional, national and international levels.

The Holy Trinity Ladies Philoptochos Society has been a part of the Lansing community since 1944. As early as 1937 the local International Women's Club of the YWCA encouraged the development of friendship bonds among the local members and an understanding of the American way of life. Local Greek women helped found that organization. They remained active for many years in the Friendship Week World Market sponsored by the YWCA. Their annual fundraising tea was a model for what was to become the Philoptochos Athenian Coffee Shop and Bake Sale. In 1944 the local Philoptochos Society was established. In 1949 the first Athenian Coffee Shop was held for the Church at the Women's Club House. Pastries were made by individual Philoptochos members at home and donated for the affair. When our local church was established, the ladies started making the pastries at the church. We continue the tradition of our founding mothers and gather in our kitchen at Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Church to make the pastries and luncheon for our annual fall event. It has been and will always be a privilege to be part of the Greater Lansing Community. We THANK YOU for supporting this event for 60 years while looking forward to the future.
